

### Rosso di Montalcino 2019 - £75

The Rosso di Montalcino is aged for 6 months in wood before bottling. Once again it is a floral, fruity and happy wine and can bridge the gap in complexity; good as a wine with snacks, yet able to take the solemnity of a heavier meal.

### Brunello di Montalcino 2017 - £125

Our Brunello di Montalcino comes from a lush loamy field on the northern slopes of Montalcino. Full-bodied and structured, it has been described in glowing terms as being fruity, opulent, corpulent, luxurious and delicious. 3 years 6 months in large Savonian oak barrels

### Brunello di Montalcino "Helichrysum" 2017 - £150

Taking its name from an aromatic wild herb, our Brunello di Montalcino Helichrysum comes from the highest vineyards on the San Polino site. It is always elegant, opulent and structured. 6 months battonage on less in french barriques, 3 years in large Slavonian and French oak barrels
